



GrackleDocs Unicode Wizard sample file

This wizard allows a simplified approach for a user to ensure the appropriate unicodes applied to text characters within the file, ensuring proper read for the end user experience.

Features include:

- Differentiation of proper vs. improper unicodes through the “Font List” and glyph display.
- Add missing unicodes - “Add Codepoints” will allow insertion of all missing codepoints. A scan will run of the file and interpret the appropriate Unicode for each missing character.
- Manual insertion of unicodes - Insert the correct Unicode character to the character field or apply the appropriate code in the code field.

Note: Incorrect Unicode Mapping does NOT show as an error in most validators, only if it's missing entirely. It is important to ensure proper coding is applied to all text characters within a document to ensure an accurate read for the end user.
